Designed to provide participants with the knowledge and skills to create a patent airway, the interventions to maintain it, and the equipment available to carry out these skills. Participants will gain the knowledge and skills required to provide the appropriate interventions, including measuring and inserting the applicable airway adjunct based on the patient's condition. Course can also be combined with Basic Life Support and Oxygen Therapy.

## **Audience**

In-facility care providers, including nursing staff, care aides, medical and dental professionals. Pre-hospital care providers, which may include professionals in a fire service, rescue team, sports-medicine, lifeguards and ski patrol.

## **Duration**

Stand-alone course or combined with BLS, course times for Airway Management are generally 1:15pm to 2:30pm
