- Administer and mark tests, collecting paperwork and submitting attendance to our training administrator.
- Ensure equipment is clean and in good working order, decontaminate all surfaces and equipment upon course completion.

Qualifications:

- Current Canadian Red Cross First Aid Instructor Certificate
- Minimum 3 years experience instructing First Aid & CPR or applicable relatable experience.
- Able to create and maintain a positive learning environment which supports the diversity of students' cultures, educational backgrounds, and learning styles.

- Valid Driver's license and reliable vehicle, must be flexible in various work environments and be willing to travel locally.
